3 Eligibility

A. General Qualification

Condition ②	Overseas Korean nationals or non-korean nationals who have completed all levels of education equivalent to elementary, middle school, high school, undergraduate and graduate school in foreign countries
Notice	Those who are stateless or have multiple nationalities with Korean nationality are not eligible to apply. If a successful applicant is confirmed to be stateless or have multiple nationalities, admission will be revoked.

4 Required Documents



Important notes of document submission

1. All application documents, forms, must be translated in Korean or English.
2. Documents issued overseas must be submitted in the form of **notarization in original**. Documents in languages other than Korean or English must be accompanied by a **notarized translation in Korean or English**.
3. Additional documents may be required for the qualification review in addition to the submitted documents. Applicants must carefully review the admission guidelines.
 - If additional documents are not provided upon request, the application may be considered incomplete.
 - Even if the online application is completed, applicants who do not submit the required documents by the deadline or who submit incomplete documents may be disqualified without further notice. (Please note that applicants are responsible for any issues arising from the postal delivery process.)
