3 Eligibility

In order to apply for CNU, applicants must meet all the qualifications related to nationality, educational background and language proficiency as below.



Nationality (Freshmen / Transfer)

- Applicants with a non-Korean nationality whose parents are also not of Korean nationality as of the date of application.
 - Both parents and applicant(student) are recognized as foreigners only if both parents and applicant(student) acquire foreign nationality before the applicant(student) begins the curriculum corresponding to Korean high school curriculum.
 - Above eligibility requirements apply to those who acquired foreign nationality through emigration or adoption (Refer to [4. Required Documents – Additional Family Relationship Documents]).
 - Applicants are not eligible if they or their parents are of South Korean nationality, possess multiple citizenship including Korean, or are stateless.



Educational Background

Freshmen	Completed (or expected to complete) studies equivalent to high school according to the Korean 12 year school system.
Transfer	<p>Completed education equivalent to high school according to the Korean school system, and meet the below conditions while being enrolled in a 4-year university. Mandatory Korean language lecture program	※ Successful applicants who fail to submit TOPIK Level 4 or CNU Language Center Korean language course certificate Level 4 before the deadline(scheduled date is a month before the beginning of the first semester) that is mentioned in the "Successful Applicant's To Do List" will be placed in a mandatory Korean language lecture program in Yeo-su campus (including those who only have submitted English certificate). This program consists of 36 credits and these credits will be counted toward the graduation credit. * Excluding transfer students and KGSP students.

4 Required Documents



Instructions for Documents Submission

- All application documents / forms / translation copies must be in Korean or English.
 - All documents submitted in a language other than Korean or English must be accompanied by a certified translation. Should it be necessary to submit a copy due to unavoidable circumstances, the original document must also be presented for verification purposes.
 - In addition to the documents submitted, supplementary materials may be required for the qualification review. It is therefore imperative to carefully review the admission guidelines.
 - Non-compliance with requests for additional documentation may result in the submission being deemed incomplete.
 - Applicants who fail to submit the required documents, or who submit incomplete documentation within the specified deadline, may be disqualified without further notification.
 - All of the submitted documents cannot be returned.
 - Every documents should be in A4 format and submitted in order, as shown in the list below.
 - All documents must be submitted in original. Submission of copy, scanned file and e-mail submissions are not permitted.
 - All personal / parental information on documents must match exactly with ID or passport information.
- * Personal / parental information includes name (spelling), date of birth, nationality, and ID or passport number.
** For Uzbekistan applicants, name (spelling) on all documents must exactly match with the English name on the international passport (red passport).

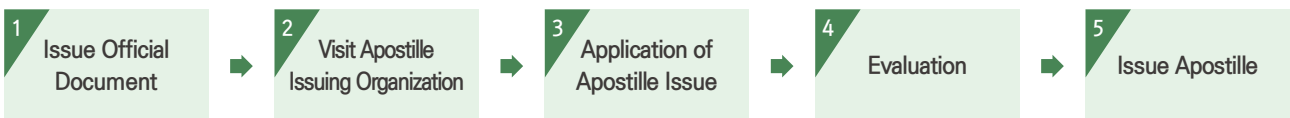

Apostille

- The Convention provides for the use of simplified certification or public documents (including notarized documents) among countries that have joined the convention. The Apostille ensures that public documents issued in one signatory country will be recognized as valid in another signatory country.

Procedure for the issuance of apostille

- Official Document (Issued by National, Public Institution)



- Private Document (Issued by Private Institution)



※ In case of a private document, there may be some difference according to the national notary and attorney's law, but usually the apostille can be checked by submitting it after receiving a notary notice from the country.

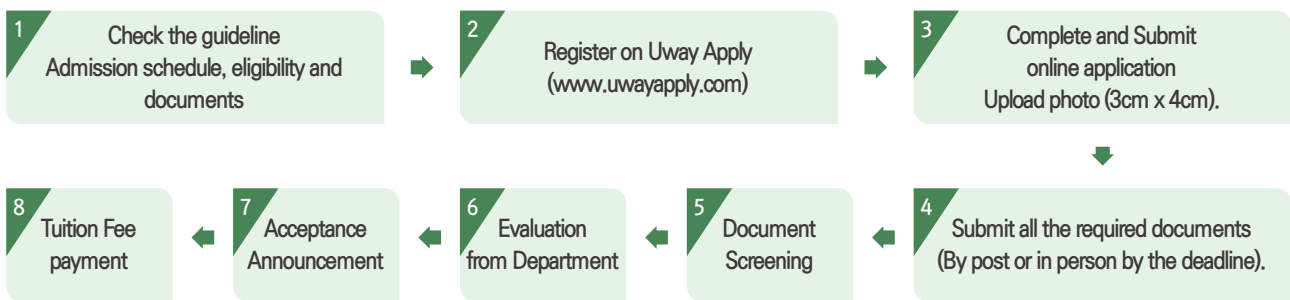

1. Applicant should choose the correct admission type (freshmen/transfer), department (major), campus, etc.
2. If applicants apply for the admission more than once in same round during the application period and possess more than one application number, all the applications will be disqualified.
3. The last day of the application period might be busy, we suggest to apply for the admission as early as possible. The system will be unavailable after the 18:00 due date.
4. As all personal information (passport information, e-mail, phone number) and information filled out by applicants are used as data for admission procedure, such as issuing acceptance letter and visa documents, accurate information must be submitted in accordance with the guidelines when applying online and if there is any changes, please notify the Office of International Affairs immediately. The applicant is responsible for all disadvantages cause by providing incorrect information or failure to notify the Office of International Affairs after the event of information change.
5. The application will be completed only if the application fee is paid.
6. After completing application fee payment, all information (including admission type, department, campus etc.) cannot be modified or cancelled.
7. Applicants will be disqualified if they fail to submit documents by deadline or if there are insufficient documents, even if they completed the online application.
8. Print out a test identification slip after completing the online application.

- Qualification screening are done by comprehensively evaluating applicant's attitude, academic proficiency and attitude for desired major. The basis of the evaluation is the documents submitted by the applicant.
 - * For the department which the interview is conducted, the interview score also will be reflected in the total score.
 - * For the College of Arts, an evaluation will be made including the portfolio submitted. (Refer to page 12)
 - Language Proficiency includes other languages, not only Korean.
 - Evaluation will be conducted based on either ① Document Evaluation 100% or ② Document Evaluation + Essential Interview. In the case of ② Document Evaluation + Essential Interview, it will be conducted face-to-face or online, (However, if the applicant is an overseas resident, online interview will be conducted, with the consideration of distance)
 - Interview varies from department to department. For department with interview, the details will be announced on the website of the International Affairs of CNU, the time and method will be informed in advance through the applicant's contact number or e-mail, which was filled in the application form. Therefore, during the evaluation period, applicants should check their contact information which they filled in the application form from time to time.
- ※ CNU does not disclose the result of evaluation scores of each process under any circumstances.

6 Important Notes

A. Applicants' Duties and Responsibilities

- Applicants should check the notice on the CNU Admissions website and e-mail for admission procedures. The applicants will take full responsibility for any disadvantages arising from non-checking.
- Applicants are responsible for errors made during the application process that may result in cancellation of admission, such as failure to submit required documents, errors or omissions in the documents, failure to fulfill the requirements indicated in the guidelines, indistinct addresses listed, correspondence failures, failure to check the acceptance list, failure to execute procedure necessary to enter the country and others.

B. Important Notes After Acceptance

- If applicants register to more than two universities within the same admission period, offer of admission will be revoked.
- Freshman can not take a leave of absence at their first semester.

- If the applicant gained admission illegally (such as by forgery or alteration of documents or translation errors of documents) or if the applicant's visa is not issued or is rejected, the admission will be canceled.
- Successful (Admitted) applicants must pay attention to "Successful Applicant's To-Do List" and complete all the procedures within the designated period. If not, applicants are subject to have their admission canceled.
- Additional documents for visa may be requested even after the admission process is completed.

C. Interpretation of Admission Guidelines

- This admission guideline is written in Korean and translated into English and Chinese. In case of any difference in interpretation, Korean version supercedes other translated versions.
- Further details, if not stated in this guideline, will be in accordance with the Office of International Affairs and Admission Committee at CNU.





